This marvelous facility was purpose-built as a retreat center by the owner, storyteller ReBekka Tippens. The 14-sided building is filled with ingenious and fanciful detail work. The main room is round, a fabulous music & dancing space with an encircling balcony, 3-story domed ceiling, and ample nooks and corners for reading, relaxing and socializing. Attendees are asked to bring clean non-street shoes or slippers for wearing inside the house. There are overnight accommodations for approximately 30 people. The majority of the beds are in small sleeping cubbies resembling ships' berths, radiating off a second floor circular hallway. There are also a number of private sleeping rooms, both in the house and in the adjacent small cottage. Bekki is a gracious host, and the food served is largely organic, local, and bountiful.

Steve and Susan Kotansky are well-known for their expertise and enthusiasm in Transylvanian dance. Steve has made many research trips to the Balkans and has taught at major folk dance camps throughout North America and Europe. He also has performed and choreographed for many performing ensembles throughout the U.S. and abroad. Steve brings a lively, in-depth knowledge to his teaching and an intense joy to his dancing.



Trei Arcuși (Three Bows), a trio of bowed string instruments, consists of Miamon Miller on violin, Chuck Corman on kontra, and Becky Ashenden on bass. Their music from Transylvania is a fine complement to Steve and Susan's dance classes. With some instrument changes, they transform into a Greek island band.



Xopo includes Miamon, Becky, and Chuck (violin, accordions, tamburas, & trombone), and adds musicians Anna Patton (clarinet), Joe Blumenthal (bass & drums), and Barbara Blumenthal (tambura). Xopo will play for evening parties and may spontaneously appear for your dancing pleasure at other times during the weekend.
